Introduction

Yah prepares before He promotes. Throughout Scripture He forms character before entrusting greater influence. This five-week study asks one question: Am I becoming the person Yah can trust? Read each passage in context, answer the observation questions honestly, study the Hebrew insights, and respond in obedience.

Week One — Formed in the Wilderness

Theme

Hidden seasons are Yah's classroom for developing humility, dependence, endurance, and obedience before Kingdom assignment.

Core Scriptures

Exodus 2–3; Deuteronomy 8:2–5; Hosea 2:14–15; James 1:2–4

The wilderness is not abandonment but formation. Yah removes distractions and teaches dependence before expanding influence.

Midbar (מִדְבָּר): the place where Yah speaks and dependence grows.

Yasar (יָסַר): loving discipline that produces maturity.
